




#### **ANIMALS AT WORK**

Did you know that animals can have jobs, just like people do? Here are just a few of the ways they help out every day:

1 Service dogs are animals that assist people who are blind, deaf or face other physical challenges. Service dogs train for hundreds, sometimes thousands, of hours to gain the skills to do their jobs.



2 Search and rescue dogs look for people who are missing, relying on their amazing sense of smell.



3 Therapy dogs help people recovering from injury or who just need companionship.















ordinary box into an outdoor or indoor scene for Belle and the Beast or other characters to play in? It's easy and fun, just follow these steps. Ask your parent or another grown-up to help.

Here are some supplies you may need:





Use a small postal box, a LEGO' box or a shoebox. Open it up and turn it on its side.



We created houses made from cut paper, and walkways from pebbles. For the inside scene use scraps of fabric to make rugs and curtains, and aluminum foil to make a mirror.



Make a background by cutting out pieces of colored paper and gluing them on the back wall of your box.



Glue anything else down that you want. Have fun creating a diorama that you can share with your friends.



3 Color the bottom using markers or paints. For an outdoor scene, try gluing on cotton wool balls for snow!



Wrap the outside of the box with paper to make it look a little nicer. Add your LEGO minifigures to the scene and create your own story!

#### **Photo Tips!**

Here are some tips on how you can take awesome photos of your models

#### **TIP 1: Composition**

Objects in your picture can be in the foreground, middle ground or background. Where they stand determines what the viewer pays attention to first.



#### TIP 2: Lighting

You can use regular lamps or flash lights. Keeping lights further away from your camera will help the model look 3-dimensional in the picture.



#### **TIP 3: Background**

A good background tells the viewer where your picture takes place, and helps give it a story. Make your own backgrounds by drawing or painting on paper or cardboard or building something with LEGO bricks.

## **WITH TRANSPARENT BRICKS!**

#### BUILD A DUCK

Here's a cute little duck you can build using pieces from your LEGO collection. Don't worry about matching the colors. You can use any colors you like.














#### **GOLDFISH**

This goldfish takes her swimming seriously as she travels through the fish tank. She's in training for the Fish Olympics!

Building the goldfish out of transparent bricks helps it "glitter" in the light, just like a real fish, and stand out from your other models.



#### UNICORN

Unicorns are one of the most popular mythical animals. Did you know that, according to legend, unicorns can tell if someone is telling the truth? Well, this is an awesome model, and that's the truth!

Using a transparent brick for part of the unicorn's horn lends the model a little sparkle.



Why do ducks fly south for the winter?

Because it's too far to waddle.




#### **WIZARD**

We're not sure if this wizard can really cast spells, but the model is pretty magical. Still, if your bricks start mysteriously disappearing, you know who to talk to.

The transparent pieces in the Wizard model could be valuable gems, enchanted crystals or whatever you choose.

#### LION

He's the "King of the Jungle", but lions don't actually live in jungles. They live on savannahs, grasslands and in open woodlands, except for this one ... he lives on your desk.



The lion's transparent mane looks awesome when you shine a torch light through it, as if he is standing in the setting sun.

#### **DUCK**

There's an old legend that a duck's quack doesn't echo. They say that's not true, but we don't know for sure. We haven't been able to get this duck to quack to test it out.



Transparent feet let this duck see where it's walking. They also give the illusion of the duck being in the crystal clear water.

A pattern is a design in which lines, shapes, forms or colors are repeated. You see them everywhere, from cups to pillowcases to bedsheets, and more. Create your own pattern using plain paper or graph paper and colored pencils. Here are some examples to help you get started.



Patterns can start from small, simple line designs. You can use straight lines, curved lines or angled lines.



Feel free to mix up different designs until you get one you really like.



Trace your design onto plain paper or graph paper multiple times until you have filled up the page. Color in your pattern.
