





AMAZING ANIMALS, TIMES THREE!

Meet a few of our favourite creatures, two who are furred and one who's a fish. What's your favourite animal?

HABITAT Tigers live in savannahs, rain forests, grasslands and mangrove swamps.

DIET Tigers are **m**

Tigers are **meat-eaters**. They eat a wide range of other animals, from **wild pigs** and **antelope** to **fish**.





Each tiger has a unique pattern of stripes, almost like a person's fingerprint. Scientists can identify a particular tiger by their stripes.

Tigers are the largest of the big cats, weighing as much as 299 kilograms and reaching 3.3 metres in length. Tiger cubs are born **blind** and don't open their eyes until they are **1-2 weeks** old. There are **fewer than 4000** tigers left in the wild. They can mostly be found in **Asia**.

Unlike many cats, tigers **love to swim** and play in the water.



Tigers are **solitary** animals, but if they are in a group, they are called an **"ambush of tigers".**





RED PANDA HABITAT

Red pandas live in the **eastern** Himalayas and southwestern China.

DIET They mainly eat bamboo leaves, grass and fruit. and sometimes acorns and roots.



Red pandas are also known as lesser pandas, red bear-cats and red cat-bears.

> Red pandas are **not bears**. They are more closely related to the **skunk** and the **weasel** (that must make for some family parties!).

(EGO CREATOR

Koi are often kept in **ponds** in outdoor gardens and are believed to bring good luck.

Koi can live to be **100** years old or longer (that's a lot of birthday cakes!).





HABITAT Modern koi are a species of **carp** originally bred in **Japan** in the 19th century.

They eat **algae**, plants, insects and worms that they stir up from the mud on the bottom of ponds and waterwavs.

Along with being a beautiful, detailed model, Sharon and Amy's creation is a reminder of how important coral reefs are to the environment and why it is important to protect them. Coral reefs provide shelter and food to many marine animals.
