



# Upside Down Animals

## How to set up & play

## How it works

The grown-ups stick LEGO® base boards underneath a table. The children get the trickier task – building an upside-down animal onto the bases.

Depending on numbers, you can either play in teams, or individually where each child gets their own base.



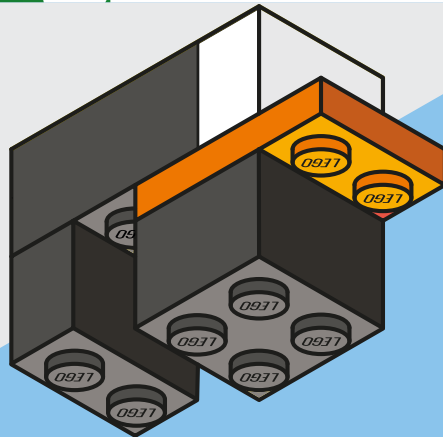
## What you need to do:

### Before the party

1. Stick the base boards underneath the table with tape.

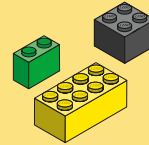
### On the day

1. Place LEGO bricks under the table for building.
2. Divide children into teams (if you have the numbers) and explain the challenge.
3. Let the fun begin!



Use double-sided tape under the base, or put a strip of tape over each corner.

LEGO bricks & baseplates



Optional extra Prize for the best creature creation.



Clock or stopwatch



Table

Or more than one depending on party numbers.



Sticky tape
