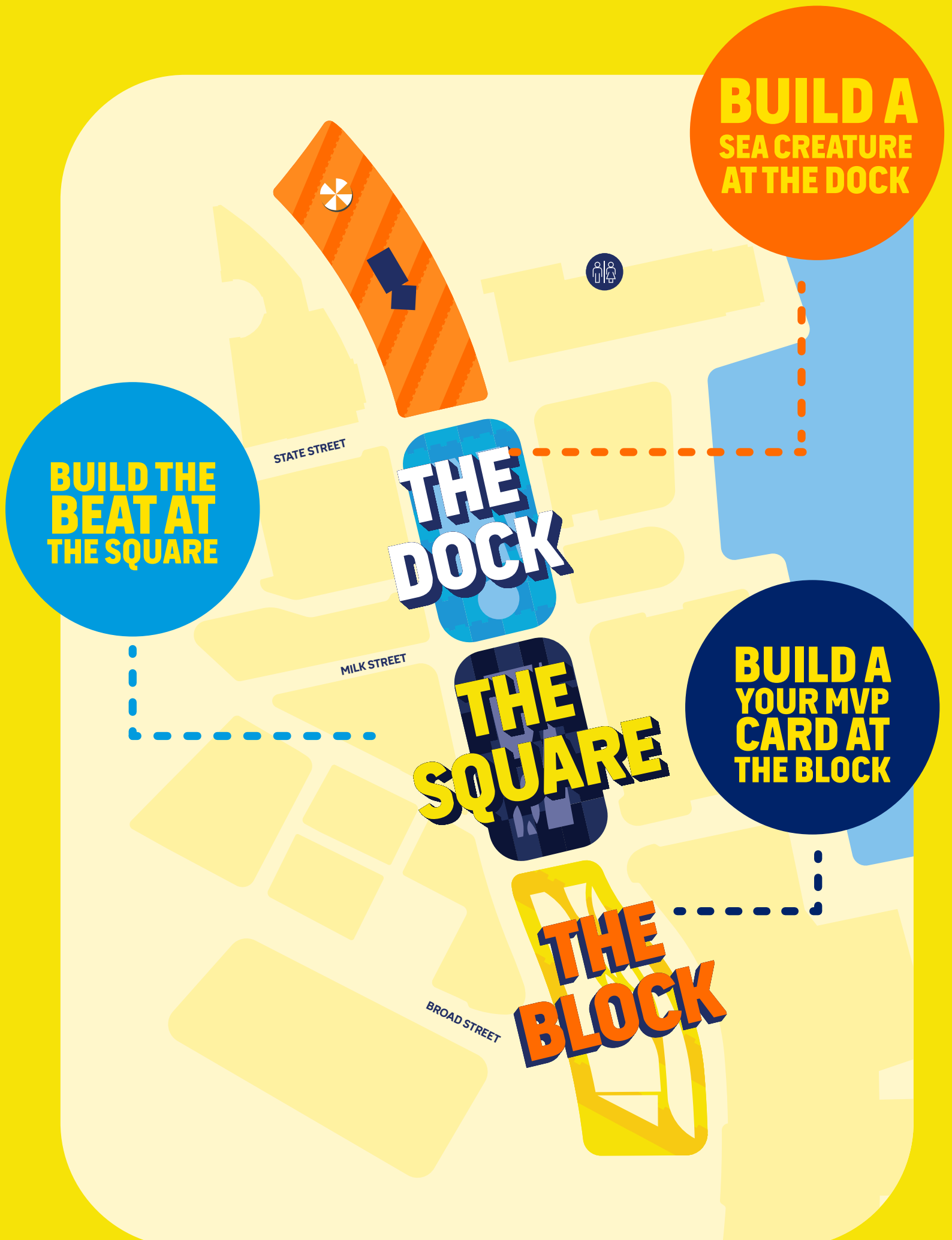

WORLD PLAY DAY BOSTON EVENT FAQs

WHERE IS IT?

- The LEGO® World Play Day event will take place on the Rose Kennedy Greenway, 191 Atlantic Ave, Boston.
- The event site begins at Atlantic Ave. and S. Market Street near the Boston Marriott Long Wharf. It runs for four blocks and ends at Atlantic Ave. and High Street.

HOW DO I GET THERE?

- We recommend using Boston's great public transportation system. The nearest T stops are Government Center on the Green Line and Aquarium on the Blue Line.
- Faneuil Hall Marketplace is a short walk from the site's entrance.
- If you're arriving by car, the nearest garages are the Harbor iParkit Garage at the corner of Atlantic Ave. and Milk Street, and the 200 State Street Garage.

June 11 - 15th, 11 am - 6 pm daily (rain or shine)

IS THERE A CHARGE TO ENTER?

LEGO® World Play Day is free for everyone!

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Everyone is welcome—LEGO® World Play Day is open to all ages! If you're under 18 years old and planning to attend without a parent or guardian present, please be sure to complete the participation waiver in advance so you can join in on the fun!

- There will also be a LEGO® DUPLO® brick area for younger builders.

WILL THE LEGO GROUP BE CAPTURING PHOTOS AND VIDEO OF THE EVENT?

- Yes. There will be a team capturing photos and video for future marketing, social media, or promotional purposes.
- If you would prefer not to appear in LEGO® photos or video, please notify staff at check-in.

CAN I BRING FOOD AND DRINK INTO THE EVENT?

- Food and drink within the event site is limited to water and hand-held snacks. But there are many places to eat nearby, including food trucks, restaurants, and Faneuil Hall Marketplace.

ARE THERE BATHROOMS AT THE EVENT SITE?

- There are public bathrooms in the site's vicinity that our on-site staff can help you locate.

IS THE EVENT ACCESSIBLE?

- The Rose Kennedy Greenway and most LEGO® World Play Day activities are accessible to persons with disabilities. On-site staff will be available to assist with accommodations, and written information will be available in English, Spanish, and Braille.

IS THERE A CODE OF CONDUCT?

- The LEGO Group is committed to creating a safe, comfortable, family-friendly experience for our guests. The following actions may result in ejection from the event:
 - Profanity or offensive language, whether spoken or appearing on clothing
 - Intoxication or signs of impairment from illicit substances
 - Bringing prohibited items into the event space
 - Damage or theft of any property
 - Behavior that may harm, endanger, or threaten other guests
 - Photos or video of children not in your own party
 - Violation of state or local laws
 - Weapons of any kind
 - Smoking or vaping materials
 - Alcohol
 - Bags, packages, or containers larger than a personal handbag or knapsack
 - Glass or metal bottles or containers
 - Professional cameras (any device with a detachable lens)
 - Selfie sticks
 - Drones
 - Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller-skates, or rollerblades
 - Pets or animals (except for clearly identified service animals)
 - Portable speakers or music players (unless using headphones)
- If you notice something that doesn't seem quite right, please alert a staff member immediately. The LEGO Group reserves the right to enforce its policies at its sole discretion. An individual or group of individuals engaged in prohibited behavior may be removed from the event site.

WILL THERE BE LOCKERS AVAILABLE?

- No, there are no lockers on site. So just bring yourself and be ready to play!

WILL THERE BE MEDICAL SERVICES ON SITE?

- Yes. An EMT will be posted at the corner of Atlantic Ave. and High Street. If you need medical assistance, please alert a staff member immediately.
