



The Big Dino Brick Hunt

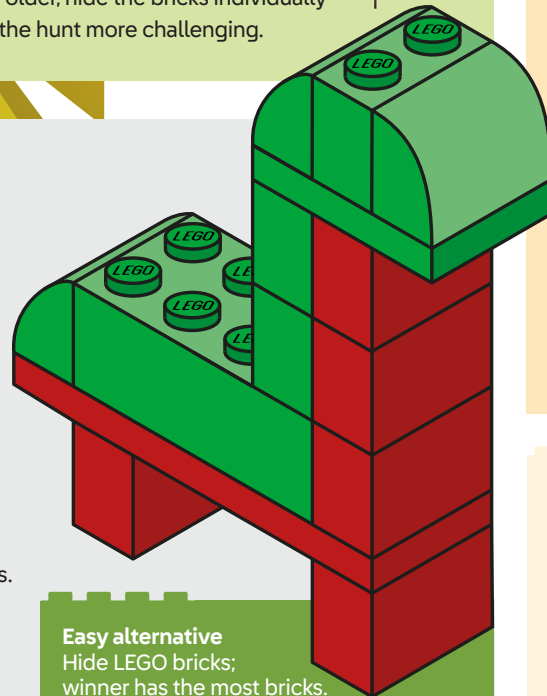
How to set up & play

How it works

Children simply have to find hidden LEGO® bricks and then build a dinosaur from them. Think of it as a treasure hunt, but with LEGO bricks.

If the children are young, you can make the hunt easier by hiding the bricks in bundles.

If they're older, hide the bricks individually to make the hunt more challenging.



Easy alternative
Hide LEGO bricks;
winner has the most bricks.

What you need to do:

Before the party

1. Gather required LEGO bricks.
2. Print dinosaur picture cards.
3. Choose a safe space for the hunt.

On the day

1. Hide LEGO bricks.
2. Split into teams or play solo.
3. Give out picture cards and buckets/bags.
4. Explain rules.
5. Start the hunt!

Things you need per team:

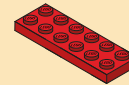
If you're hosting a small party, children can play as individuals.

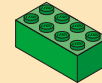


x5 1x2 LEGO bricks

x1 4x2 LEGO brick



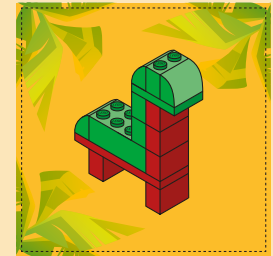
x3 1x2 LEGO bricks
