



Unicorn Rainbow Match

How to set up & play

How it works

Take 5 pairs of matching LEGO bricks (giving you 10 in total). Hide each individual brick under its own cup. Children turn over 2 cups to try and find a matching pair.

They keep the pairs they find. If it's not a match, they call out which bricks they uncovered, and return the cups for the next player.



Things you need:



5 pairs of matching LEGO bricks

Each pair should be a different brick size/color to the other pairs.



Optional extra
Prize for the best brick matcher.



10 cups



What you need to do:

On the day

1. Place 10 cups upside down on a table/flat surface.
2. Put a different LEGO brick under each one, try not to place the brick pairs too close to one another.
3. Explain the task and how the game ends when all the pairs are found.



Unicorn facts:

Unicorns can be any color – not just white.
