

Amendment to the Rules

“THE ESSENTIAL OBJECT OF YOUR HOLIDAYS”

Reminder:

Ubi Bene, a simplified joint stock company with a share capital of €102,333.60, whose registered office is located at 11 rue d’Uzès 75002 PARIS, registered with the Paris Trade and Companies Register under number 431 358 670 (hereinafter referred to as the “Organising Company”), is organising, in its own name and on behalf of LEGO S.A.S., a contest (hereinafter referred to as the “Contest”) from June 30, 2025 to August 26, 2025 to offer tickets to participate in the LEGO® Grand Tournament des Champs (the “LEGO® Grand Tournament des Champs”) which will take place on September 21, 2025 on the Champs-Élysées in Paris.

Pursuant to Articles 6 and 9 of the rules filed with the SCP SIMONIN – LE MAREC & GUERRIER, Judicial Officers in Paris, the Organising Company has decided to modify both the number of teams selected and the closing date of the Contest.

As a result, Articles 1, 2, 4 and 5 have been amended as follows:

ARTICLE 1 – THE ORGANISING COMPANY

Ubi Bene, a simplified joint stock company with a share capital of €102,333.60, whose registered office is located at 11 rue d’Uzès 75002 PARIS, registered with the Paris Trade and Companies Register under number 431 358 670 (hereinafter referred to as the “Organising Company”), is organising, in its own name and on behalf of LEGO S.A.S., a contest (hereinafter referred to as the “Contest”) from June 30, 2025 to September 10, 2025 to offer tickets to participate in the LEGO® Grand Tournament des Champs (the “LEGO® Grand Tournament des Champs”) which will take place on September 21, 2025 on the Champs-Élysées in Paris.

ARTICLE 2 – CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTEST

Participation in the Contest is free of charge, with no purchase required, and entails full and unconditional acceptance of these Rules. By submitting their entry, Participants are deemed to have fully accepted the Rules.

Participation in the Contest requires that at least one member of the team holds a “LEGO Insiders” loyalty account (creation of a LEGO Insiders account is free).

The Contest is open to any natural person over the age of 6 (six) on the date of registration, with the exception of employees and permanent or temporary collaborators of the Organising Company, LEGO S.A.S., and their families, as well as more generally anyone involved in the organisation of the Contest.

Only one entry per person (same name, same address) is allowed.

To register and try their luck, Participants must visit the website <https://www.lego.com/fr-fr/le-grand-tournoi-des-champs/concours> and follow the instructions provided. Registrations are open from June 30, 2025 to September 10, 2025; any entry submitted outside these dates will be invalid.

Participation in the Contest is team-based. Teams must consist of a minimum of 3 (three) and a maximum of 4 (four) participants (hereinafter “Participant(s)”), with one Participant designated as the team’s representative applicant.

The team’s representative applicant must:

- either be of legal age on the date of registration, in which case the other team members may be Participants aged 6 (six) years and over;
- or be at least 16 (sixteen) years old on the date of registration, in which case at least one of the other team members must be of legal age and hold parental authority over the representative applicant.

Any participation by a minor requires written authorisation from one of the holders of parental authority, including for the collection and processing of the minor’s personal data. The Organising Company may request proof of this authorisation at any time, particularly if the minor is designated as a winner. Failure to provide such authorisation will invalidate the team’s registration and, in the event of selection, result in disqualification and loss of prize entitlement without appeal or compensation.

The Organising Company reserves the right to carry out any checks necessary to verify identity, age, address, eligibility and/or number of entries. Any registration containing incomplete, inaccurate or false information, or any fraudulent entry, will be deemed invalid.

ARTICLE 4 – SELECTION OF WINNERS

Entries will be judged on two main criteria: creativity and execution quality.

Each entry must be made up of a maximum of 300 LEGO elements. Teams exceeding this limit will be disqualified.

Participants undertake to guarantee the originality of their creations and must not copy, in whole or in part, pre-existing works or use artificial intelligence. Any breach will result in automatic disqualification.

The best creations will be pre-selected by the Organising Company and submitted to a jury composed of LEGO S.A.S. employees (the “Jury”), who will select the winners between June 30 and September 10, 2025.

The Jury will select winners progressively. For Participants’ information, the LEGO® Grand Tournament des Champs will feature 256 teams. This Contest will select 220 teams, with the remaining teams recruited via other independent methods.

The Jury will designate the 220 winning teams at its discretion, ensuring equal treatment of all candidates. The decision of the Organising Company and LEGO S.A.S. is final and cannot be appealed.

ARTICLE 5 – PRIZES

- One ticket for each member of the 220 winning teams to participate in the LEGO® Grand Tournament des Champs, held on September 21, 2025 on the Champs-Élysées in Paris.

The Organising Company will contact by email either the team leader or the designated representative applicant to confirm availability of the team members and validate ticket delivery.

If no response is received within 3 working days of first contact, the team forfeits its prize, which will be awarded to another winner.

Prizes cannot be contested, exchanged, transferred or converted into cash. The Organising Company reserves the right to replace prizes, in whole or in part, with equivalent prizes if circumstances beyond its control so require, without incurring liability.

The amended rules are annexed to this amendment and filed with the SCP SIMONIN – LE MAREC & GUERRIER, Judicial Officers in Paris.
