How to set up & play



How it works

Let's imagine the children's LEGO® dinosaurs (from the Dino Design activity) need saving from a volcano.

To rescue them, the children need to build a LEGO vehicle that can carry (and race) their dinosaurs to safety.

What you need to do:

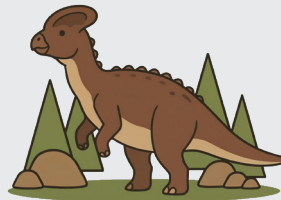
If your party hasn't already played Dino Design, Step 1 will be to get the children to make their own LEGO dinosaurs, see this activity for more details.

Before the party

1. Mark out the racetrack – this could be with cones or just a finishing line.

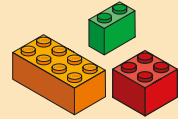
On the day

1. Put all the children's LEGO dinosaurs together in the path of the volcano.
2. Get the children building their LEGO vehicles.
3. Explain how the vehicles start at one point, pick up the dinosaurs, then drive to the finish line.
4. There are no rules. The vehicles just need to have wheels and carry the dinosaurs.
5. Once built, start their engines and go!



To make the racetrack more challenging, you could put obstacles in their vehicle's path.

Things you need:



LEGO bricks



Objects

To mark your safe area and volcano area.



Optional extra

Prize for the vehicle that saves a dinosaur first.



Dinosaur facts:

Some dinosaurs had over 1,000 teeth, like the plant-eating Hadrosaurus.

The smallest dinosaurs were only about the size of a chicken.
