



Magical Unicorn Says...

How to set up & play

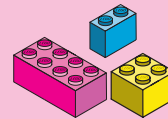
How it works

You nominate a Head Unicorn (it can be a grown up, or the birthday child). They call out 'Unicorn says...' followed by a LEGO® build challenge of their choosing.

The others have 5 minutes to build it from the build instructions that your Head Unicorn calls out. And if the child forgets to say 'Unicorn says...' the other children can't build it.



Things you need:



LEGO bricks



Optional extra
Prize for the best build.



A clock or stopwatch



What you need to do:

On the day

1. Get the LEGO bricks ready for building.
2. Nominate your Head Unicorn and ask them to think of the LEGO build.
3. Explain the task and set your timer to 5 minutes.
4. Head Unicorn calls out 'Unicorn says...build a rainbow bridge' for example.
5. After 2 minutes everyone shows each other their build.
6. Nominate a new Head Unicorn and play another round.

Unicorn facts:

A unicorn with wings is a pegacorn.
Unicorns were said to run without touching the ground.



15 mins

5 minutes per round.
One person calls out a LEGO challenge and the others try to build it.
