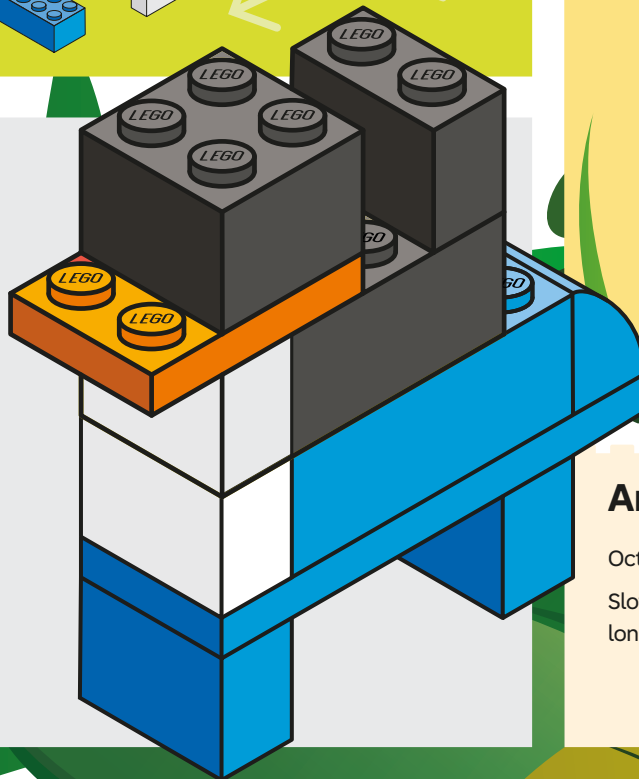
How to set up & play

After building, they can give it a name, or even a fun sound effect.

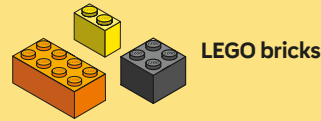


What you need to do:
