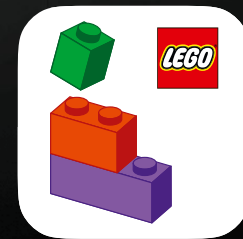

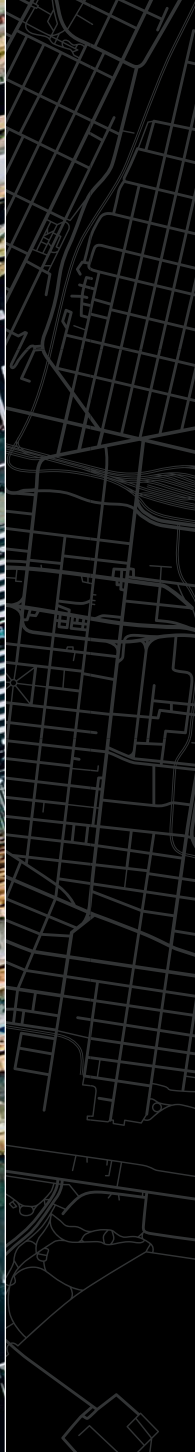

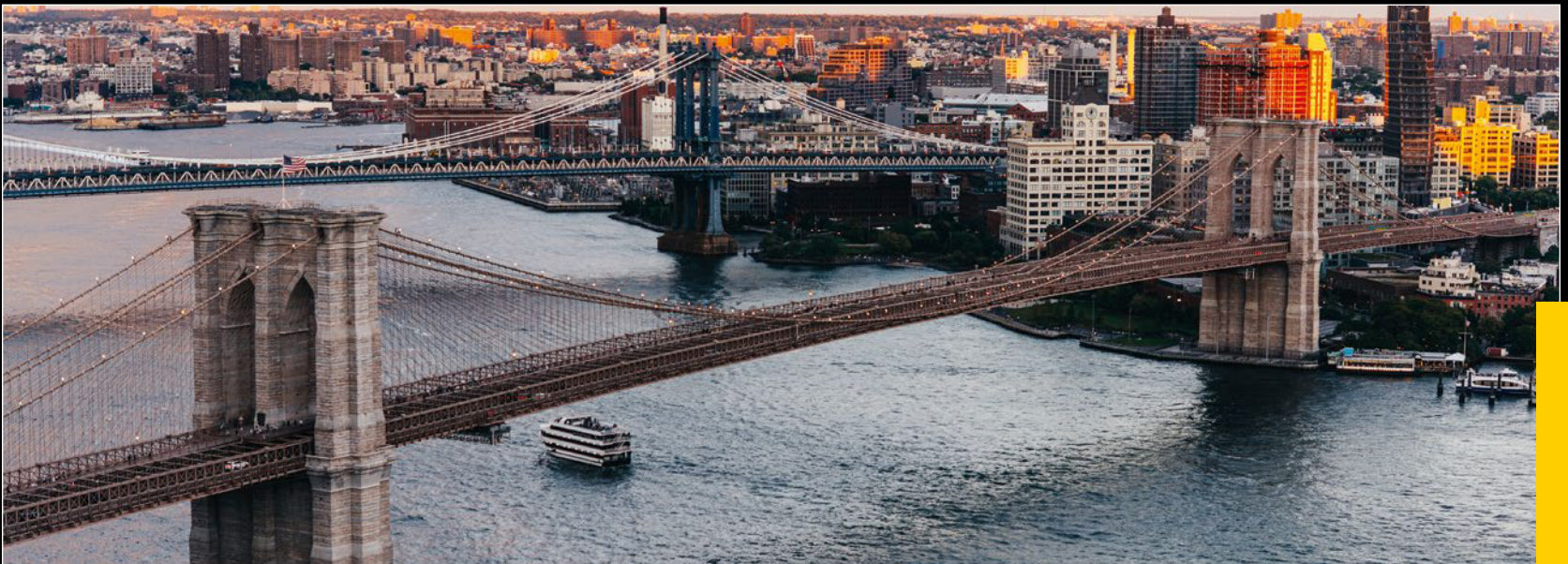






THE BIG APPLE
