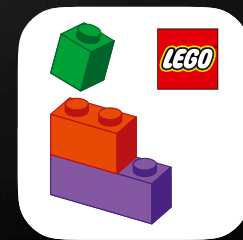

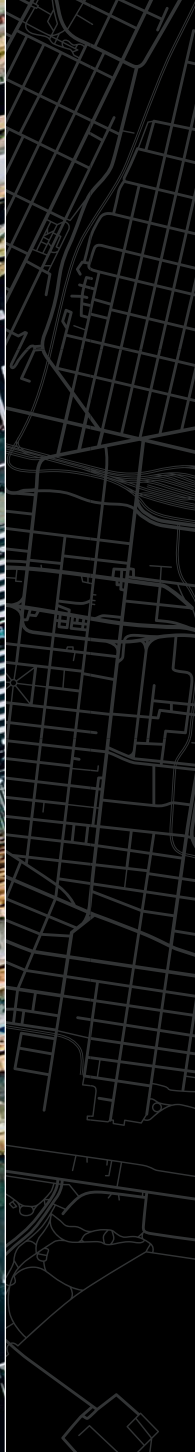

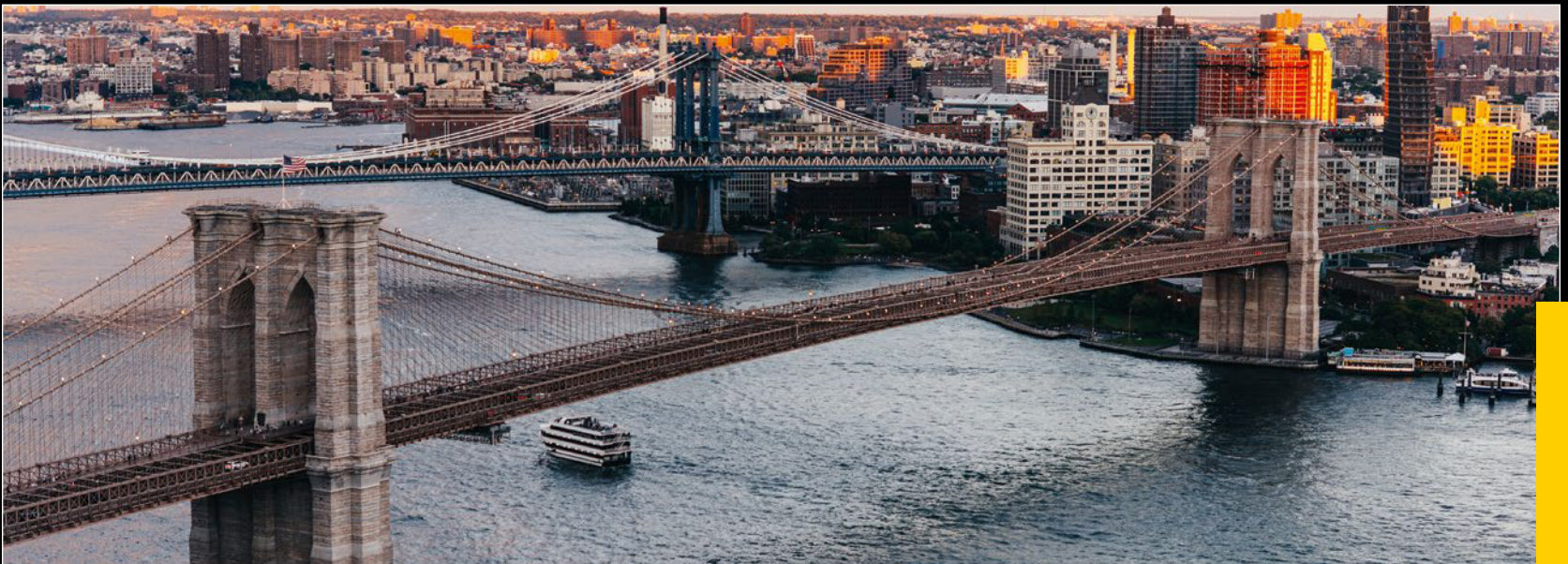






# LA GRAN MANZANA

Este icono neoyorquino de 102 plantas ofrece unas vistas impresionantes de la ciudad desde el corazón de Midtown Manhattan.



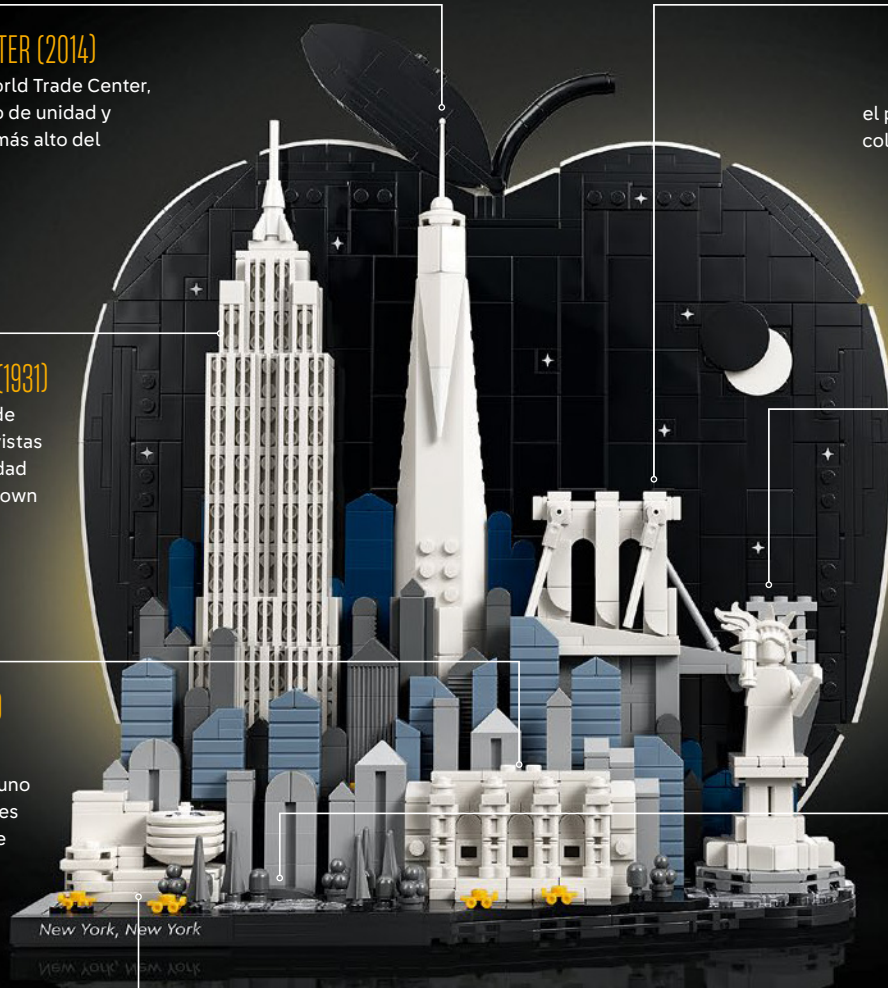
### MUSEO METROPOLITANO DE ARTE (1870)

### CENTRAL PARK (1858)

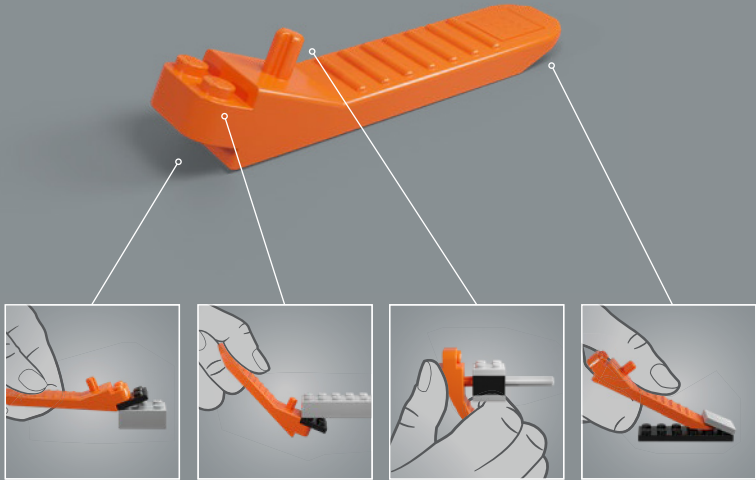
Central Park recibe 42 millones de visitantes al año en sus más de 341 hectáreas de praderas, senderos y lagos.

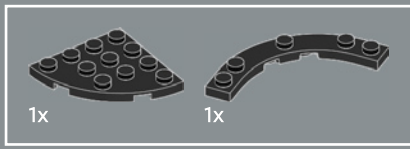


# IMPRESIONES DEL EQUIPO DE DISEÑO DE LEGO® ARCHITECTURE

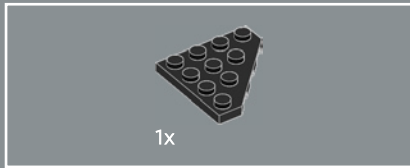
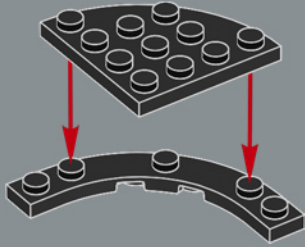
En 2026 se cumplen 250 años de la firma de la Declaración de Independencia de los Estados Unidos, efeméride que coincide con el 10.º aniversario de nuestro primer set LEGO® Architecture con la silueta urbana de Nueva York. Animados por ambos eventos, decidimos celebrarlos recreando algunos de los monumentos neoyorquinos más populares, reinterpretados contra un fondo que representa el cielo nocturno de la Gran Manzana. Usamos elementos facetados para reproducir la compleja geometría del One World Trade Center, que se apoya sobre los “hombros” del Empire State Building y se estrecha a medida que gana altura. Las ventanas y las largas líneas verticales *art déco* del Empire State Building se reproducen usando placas de rejilla LEGO. El modelo del Puente de Brooklyn juega con un efecto de perspectiva forzada mediante el drástico cambio de tamaño, las variaciones de color de ambas torres y la ligera inclinación de la calzada. Esperamos que disfrutes construyendo y explorando esta magnífica ciudad, que incluye otros inconfundibles detalles, ¡como la Dama de la Libertad en forma de minifigura!



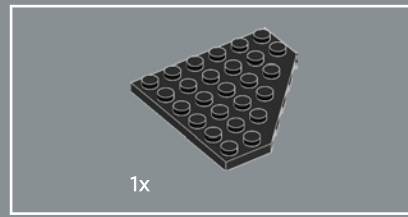
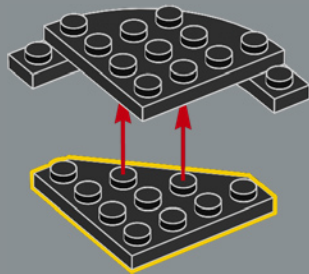




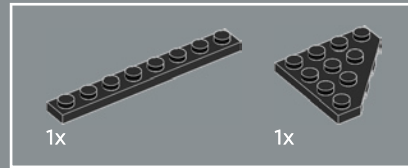
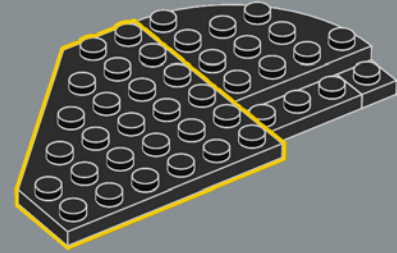
