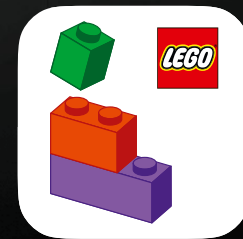

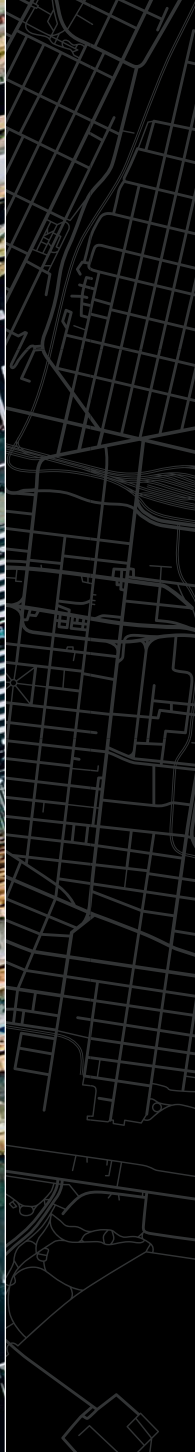

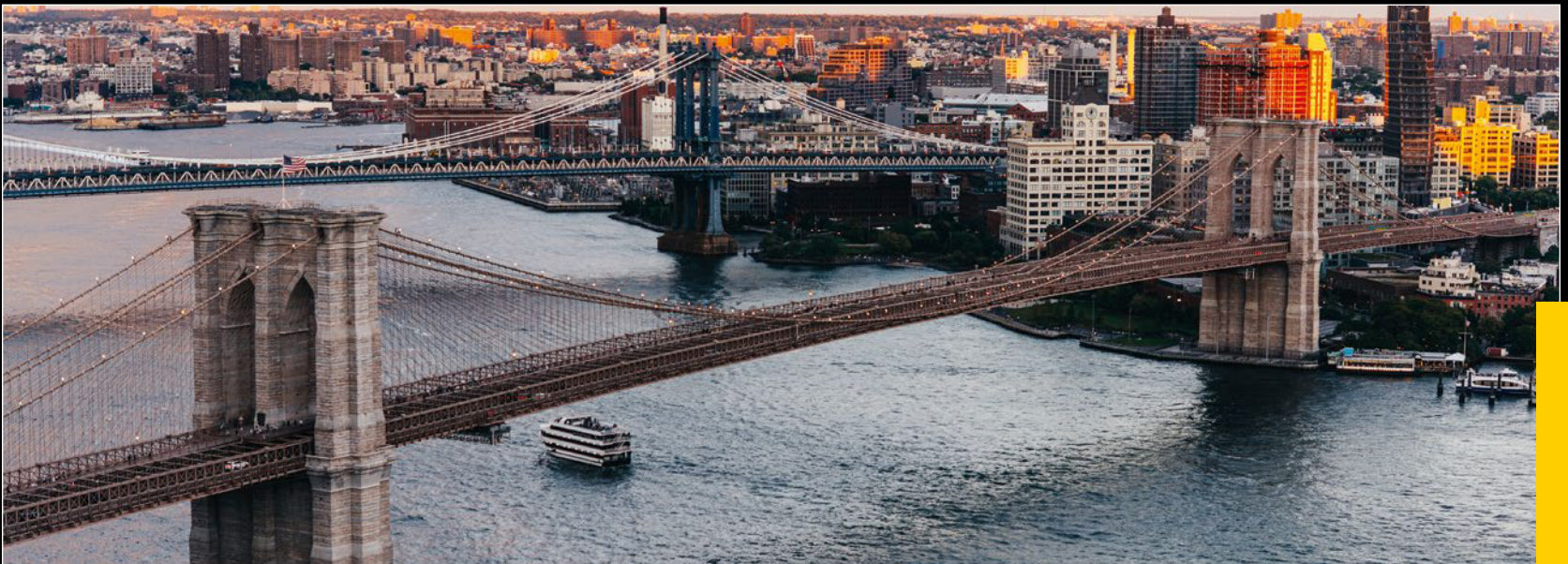






LA GROSSE POMME

Ce monument new-yorkais de 102 étages offre des vues spectaculaires sur la ville depuis le cœur de Midtown Manhattan.



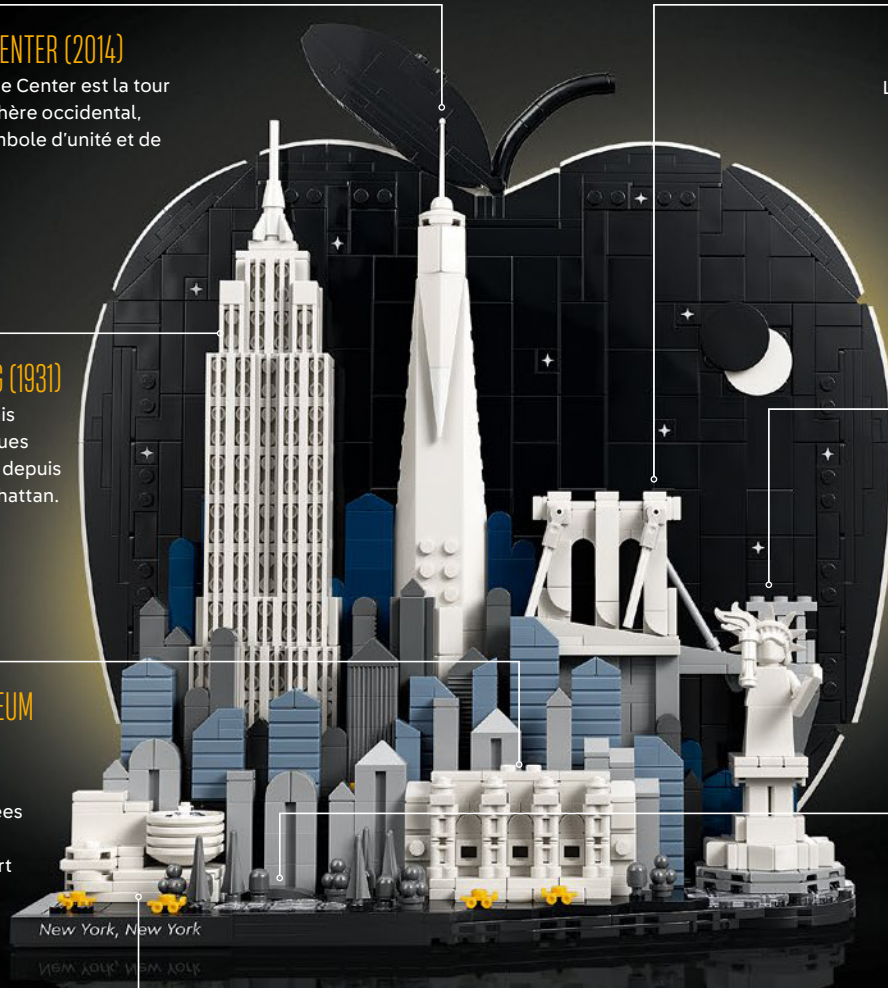
LE METROPOLITAN MUSEUM OF ART (1870)

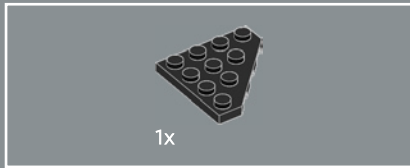
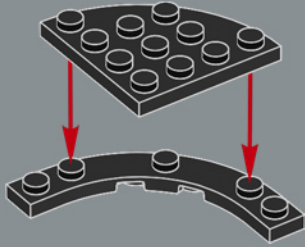
2026 marque le 250^e anniversaire de la signature de la Déclaration d'indépendance des États-Unis ET le 10^e anniversaire de notre tout premier set LEGO® Architecture New York City Skyline ! Cette double célébration nous a inspirés à revisiter les monuments les plus célèbres de New York dans un décor de « Big Apple » sous un ciel nocturne. Nous avons utilisé des éléments à facettes pour reproduire la géométrie complexe du One World Trade Center, posé sur les « épaules » de l'Empire State Building et qui s'affine à mesure qu'il s'élève. Des plaques de grille LEGO ont été utilisées pour créer les fenêtres et les longues lignes Art déco verticales de l'Empire State Building. La construction du pont de Brooklyn joue sur un effet de perspective forcée, en modifiant fortement les tailles, en ajoutant des variations de couleurs sur les deux tours et en inclinant légèrement la chaussée. Avec d'autres détails emblématiques, comme « Lady Liberty » en minifigurine, nous espérons que vous prendrez autant de plaisir à construire qu'à explorer cette ville magnifique !



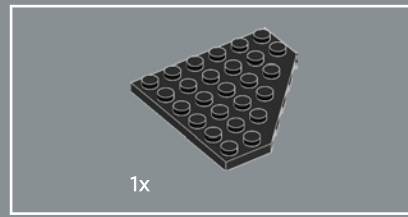
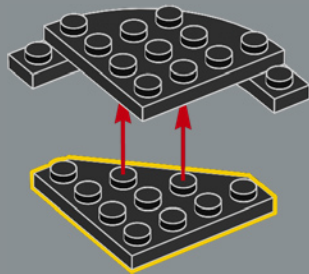




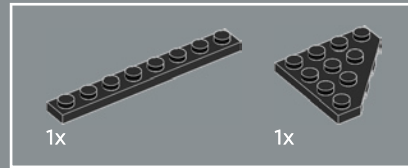
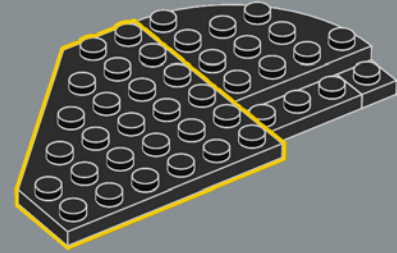
