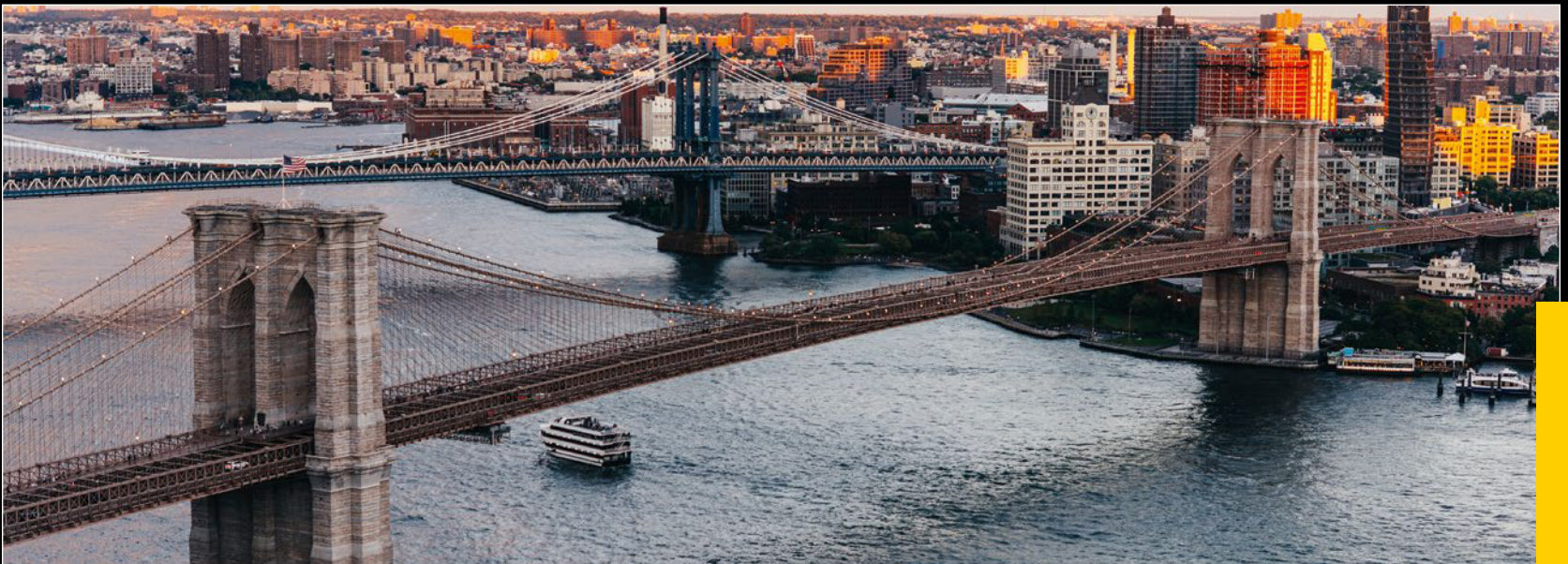






THE BIG APPLE

The 102-storey New York icon offers stunning views of the city from the heart of Midtown Manhattan.



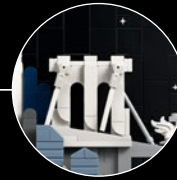
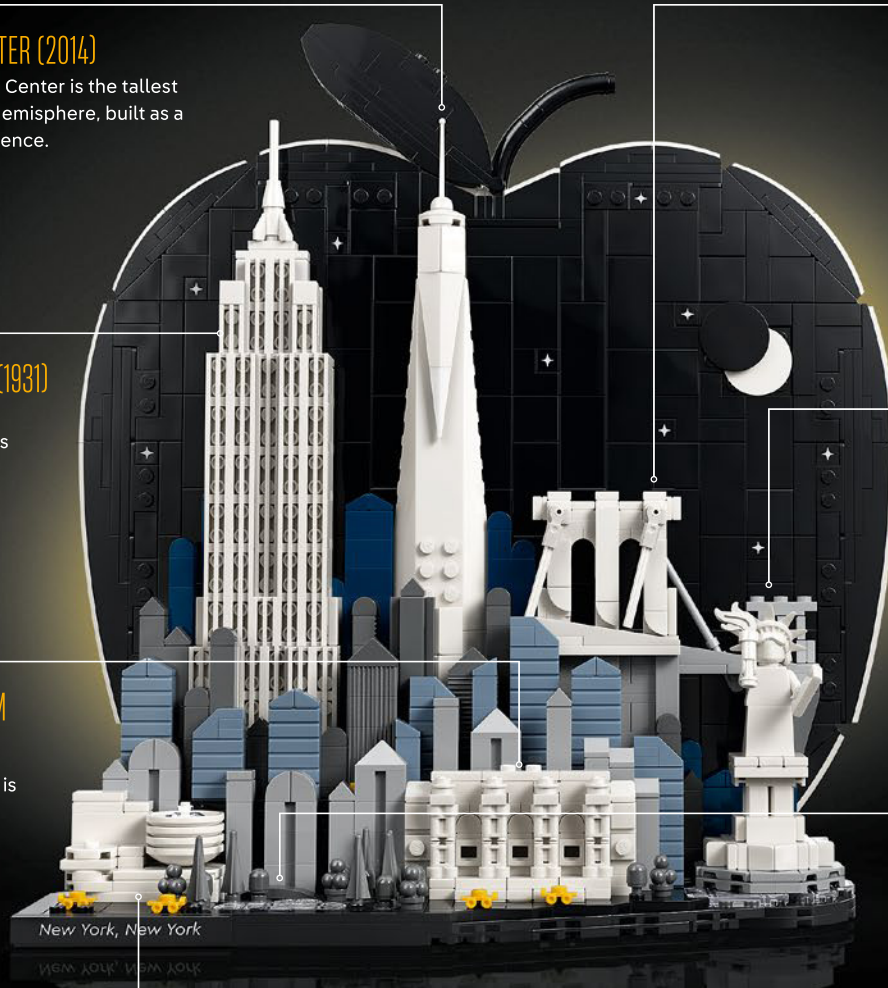
METROPOLITAN MUSEUM OF ART (1870)

Founded in 1870, The Met is one of the world's largest museums, showcasing more than 5,000 years of art history and modern masterpieces.



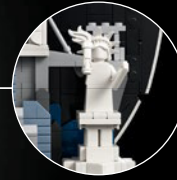
SOLOMON R. GUGGENHEIM MUSEUM (1959)

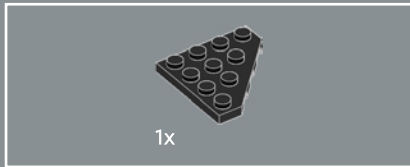
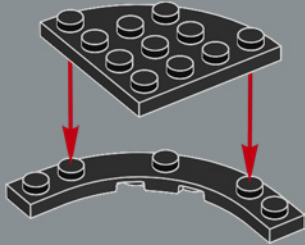
2026 marks the 250th anniversary of the signing of the United States Declaration of Independence AND the 10th anniversary of our first LEGO® Architecture New York City Skyline set! That inspired us to celebrate both occasions, with famous New York landmarks reinterpreted against a 'Big Apple' backdrop depicting a night sky. We used faceted elements to replicate the intricate geometry of One World Trade Center as it rests on the 'shoulders' of the Empire State Building and tapers as it rises. LEGO grille plates make up the windows and long upwards Art Deco lines on the Empire State Building. The build of the Brooklyn Bridge plays with a forced perspective effect, by drastically changing the size, adding colour variations in both towers and adding a slight angle to the road. With other iconic details, like 'Lady Liberty' as a minifigure, we hope you have fun building and exploring this magnificent city!



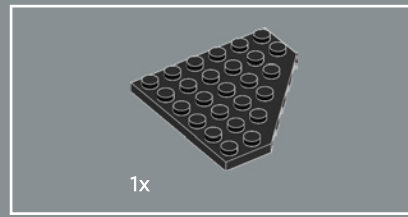
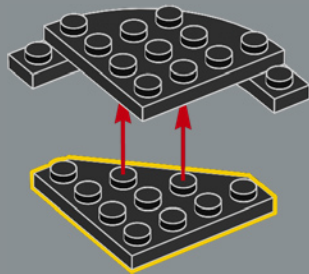




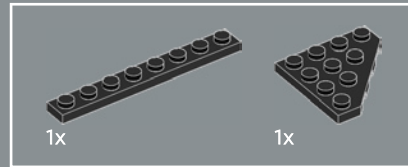
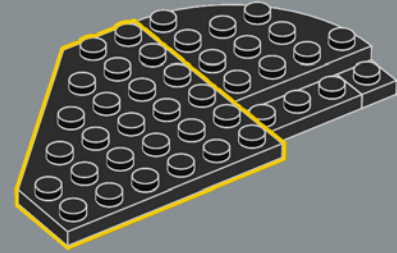
