Tree of Creativity

In the midst of LEGO® House stands one of the world's most iconic LEGO models. At more than 15m tall, The Tree of Creativity is one of the largest and most technically challenging LEGO models ever built. If it would have been built by one person only it would have taken her 12 years of work!

The tree represents the LEGO Group itself as a strong brand; a strong tree that has stood the test of time and the company's heritage in wooden toys represented by the carvings at the base of the tree, including the iconic duck. The unfinished branch at the top of the tree symbolizes the continued growth and evolution of the LEGO Group, which is still 'under construction'.

The generations of family ownership are illustrated by names and initials carved into the trunk

The Waterfall

The LEGO model waterfall represents an unlimited supply of bricks that flow into the room. Just like all the other models in LEGO® House, it was built by hand - in this case by using only standard LEGO® bricks.

If you yourself wanted to build a copy of the waterfall, it would take you more than 5 years...it took a team of professional LEGO model builders around 29 weeks to build.

For many years, the LEGO Group has made model logos in bricks for use in offices and factories around the world. These have traditionally been built using single colour LEGO® Minifigures, however for the History Collection in LEGO House we have been using many different types of LEGO elements.

LEGO Furniture

All furniture in the Experience Zones inside the LEGO House can be made out of LEGO bricks. In fact, that also goes for the Wayfinding that has been kept in the same scale, and built like children will build it. The scale is 1:18,75, which by the way is the same scale of the ceramic tiles that cover the walls.
